1. Thank you for your expressed interest in the Fit To Win/Wellness Program. Fit To Win is the Army's worksite wellness program. Our mission is to enhance military readiness and civilian wellness through fitness, nutrition, and health education. We achieve this mission through clinical screenings, education, physiological testing, and exercise programming designed to modify unhealthy lifestyle risks and improve healthy ones.
2. In order to better serve our customer's needs we ask that each individual complete a Personal Wellness Profile (PWP). The PWP is a comprehensive assessment that provides us with valuable information on your overall wellness rating, current fitness level, and personal heart health. As part of the PWP process we conduct cholesterol and blood pressure screenings that add valuable information on your cardiovascular disease risk. On Sunday March 7<sup>th</sup> we are offering this screening to you. Each individual will be given a cholesterol and blood pressure test, which will take approximately 10 minutes to complete. Fasting for the cholesterol test is not required.
3. The results of these tests will be added to your PWP profile report. Your results are treated as Personal Health Information and are confidential and will not be released without your authorization. You will be briefed on your overall PWP results on Tuesday March 9<sup>th</sup>, and learn more about our program. We greatly appreciate the opportunity to work with you and look forward to seeing you on March 7<sup>th</sup>.
